UPDATE ISS Young Horse Class Qualifying Events August – December 2010.

The Major Series ISS Qualifiers

A series of events being held specifically for Young Horses 4,5 and 6 year old during the period August to December. The Courses have specifications for each age group to promote continuity throughout the series. This series is designed to help the development and preparation of our young horses. It will be based on clear rounds and jumping technique.

Age Divisions & Heights

4 year olds born between August 06- Aug 07.

Course maximum @ 90cm

5 year olds born between August 05- Aug 06.

Course maximum @ 1metre

6 year olds born between August 04- Aug 05.

Course maximum @ 1.10m

The Scoring System

Due to bad weather two of the ISS Oaks Medallion Young Horse Major Series Qualifier Events had to be cancelled. At the qualifying events the top ten horses, based on penalties from the first round, will go through to the second round. The second round will be then judged by a separate subjective judge on their jumping technique. The following shows and qualifying system will now take place:-

The Final:

The Oaks Medallion Final will be held at the ISS Summer Showjumping Classic CSI-W, 9th December, 2010 at SIEC. Twenty Horses will be invited into the final:-

- The top three from each Major Series qualifier event
- The overall winner of the ESP Mini Series 4 year old will go automatically into the 5 year olds.
- The overall winner of the ESP Mini Series 5 year old will go automatically into the 6 year olds.
- 4 wild cards and/or interstate horses for the 4 & 5 year olds.
- 5 wild cards and/or interstate horses for the 6 year olds.
